The role of the ECPC is to ensure a safe, efficient and effective functioning payments system in the ECCU.

The CAB applauds the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank and its much-anticipated reconstitution of the ECPC to strengthen its oversight of the ECCU payments and settlement systems. Deputy Governor of the ECCB, Mr. Trevor Barthwaite, serves as the chairman of the Council.
